- 1. The Regular Meeting was called to order at 6:03 p.m.
- 2. Colebrook Board of Education Chairman Sara Robichaud opened the Colebrook Board of Education 2025-26 budget presentation with a depiction of the town's return on investment to the school. Superintendent Robert Gilbert subsequently continued the presentation and answered individual line-item questions from board members for the Colebrook Board of Education 2025-26 Budget which indicated:
 - a. General Operating Expenses have an overall budget request increase of 1.39%.
 - b. Special Education Expenses have an overall budget request increase of 4.37%.
 - c. Combined they result in an overall Colebrook Board of Education 2025-2026 Budget request increase of 5.76% or \$122,824 from the 2024-25 budget.
- 3. Chairman Wilber distributed an overview of the 2024 Grand List of Taxable Property current as of January 28, 2025, for review and discussion by the board.
- 4. The current Budget Outlook was presented with discussion of the mill rate outlook and potential issues for the 2025-26 budget.
- 5. The school HVAC project will resume work in late April or early May.
- 6. Meeting minutes approval:
 - a. The Board of Finance Regular Meeting Minutes of December 12, 2024, were reviewed. Item 2 is amended to read: "2. The Board of Finance contact list was updated and potential members were discussed that could be asked to fill the vacancy on the board following a Special Meeting." M. Masslon made a motion, seconded by K. Adams, "Motion to approve the December 12, 2024, regular meeting minutes with amended line 2." Motion passed unanimously.

- b. The Board of Finance Special Meeting Minutes of February 11, 2025, were reviewed. K. Adams made a motion, seconded by M. Masslon, "Motion to approve the February 11, 2025, special meeting minutes." Motion passed unanimously.
- 7. Motion was made by S. Norton, seconded by T. McKeon, to adjourn the meeting at 7:09 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
